

## Mission Statement and Purpose

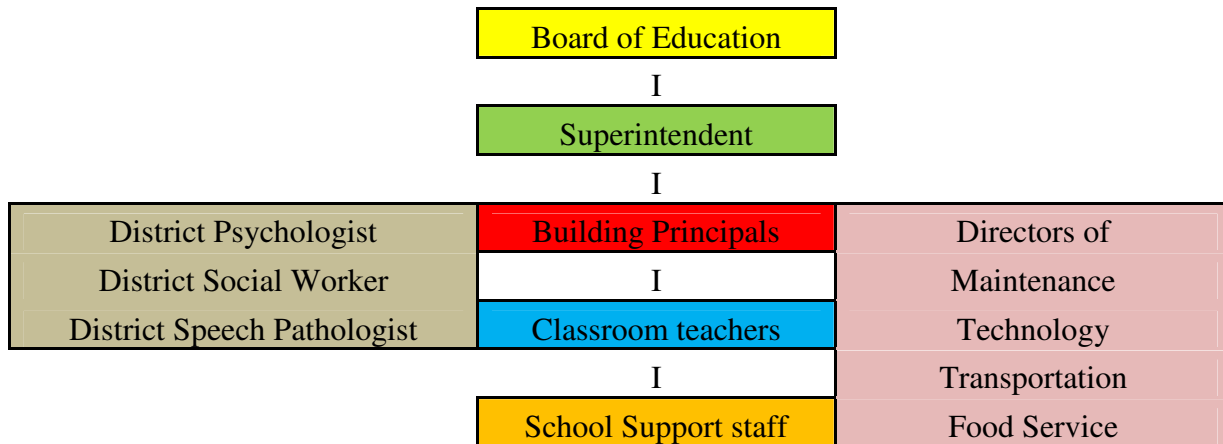
### WALLACE GRADE SCHOOL VISION STATEMENT
