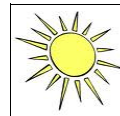
Important Dates:

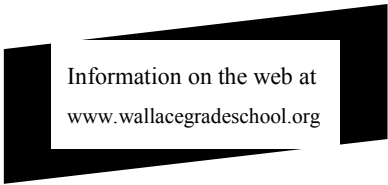
